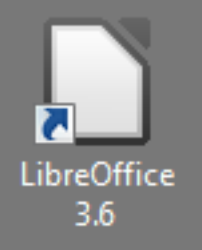


How to Report All Folders and Permissions below c:\%USERPROFILE%\Documents.

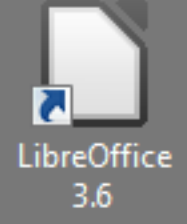
